11-23-2023 Happy Thanksgiving



I find it ironic that today is Thanksgiving, a day of being thankful, which lasts for around 24 hours. Tomorrow is Black Friday, where we get incredible deals. It's the biggest shopping day of the year.

In the mean time a team of researchers found a new structure in space. Did you know of inside of you lies the microcosm of the universe?

Regarding the new structure in space, a team of researchers has discovered a new structure in space called the 'South Pole Wall' that spans 1.4 billion light years across ¹. It is a part of the cosmic web that strings galaxies together like pearl necklaces via huge strands of hydrogen gas ¹. The structure surrounds large empty voids and has been picked up on stunning 3D maps of the universe ¹. It's fascinating to know that inside this structure lies the microcosm of the universe ¹.

- Cosmic Vine discovery: A team of researchers have found a new structure in the cosmic web that links 20 galaxies in the early universe¹. They call it the Cosmic Vine and it is 13 light years long and 11-12 billion years old.
- Cosmic web and galaxy formation: The cosmic web is made of filaments of gas that connect galaxies. These filaments are important for delivering the materials that galaxies need to grow². The Cosmic Vine is a large-scale structure that can help us understand how galaxy clusters form and evolve.

• Quiescent galaxies puzzle: The Cosmic Vine contains two massive galaxies that have stopped forming stars, which is unusual for such an early stage of the universe³. The researchers do not know what caused this quenching of star formation. They suggest two possible explanations: a starburst due to galaxy mergers or a supermassive black hole feedback.



11-25-2023 Mysterious cosmic ray came from beyond our galaxy, scientists say

- Ultra-high-energy cosmic ray: A rare subatomic particle with enormous energy was detected by a cosmic ray observatory in Utah. It is nicknamed the Amaterasu particle after the Japanese sun goddess¹².
- Origin and mystery: The particle is believed to have traveled from beyond the Milky Way galaxy, but its exact source is unknown³. It seems to come from an empty region of space called the **Local Void**⁴⁵.
- <u>Implications and challenges: The</u> particle is one of the most energetic ever observed, rivaling the **Oh-My-God particle**

from 1991⁶. It could help scientists understand the most extreme phenomena in the universe, such as black holes and gamma-ray bursts. However, finding and studying such particles is very difficult due to their rarity and unpredictability.

- The mind and the universe: How studying human consciousness and artificial intelligence can help us understand the physical reality and the mysteries of the cosmos.
- Neural networks and theories of mind: How interconnected computing units can simulate the brain's processes and give rise to emergent properties such as consciousness. Two leading theories are predictive coding and integrated information.
- Quantum physics and consciousness: How the mind may have a role in the quantum phenomena such as collapse and entanglement, and how these phenomena may challenge our notions of reality, free will, and spacetime.
- **Interdisciplinary and philosophical challenges**: How researchers from different fields and backgrounds are trying to tackle the hard problem of consciousness and its implications, and how they face conceptual and empirical difficulties.
